2 Timothy 3:2 DEFINITIONS

1. Lovers of Their Own Selves

Those that are consumed with their own interests; put themselves and their own interests above all else; self-promoting; self-devoted; self-enamored.

2. Covetous

Wanting, craving or desiring a thing – specifically something belonging to another person (See Exodus 20:17). May include possessions, positions, abilities (talents, skills, giftings, etc.) or power (influence).

(See Ephesians 5:5 and Colossians 3:5)

3. Boastful

Showing (displaying; communicating) excessive pride in one's own achievements, accomplishments, possessions, talents or abilities. Bragging; vaunting oneself up (1 Corinthians 13:4); ostentatious (displaying one's wealth, knowledge, skill, ability or appearance (looks) in a way meant to attract attention, admiration and envy).

4. Proud

A deep feeling of satisfaction or importance – as a result of one's own achievement, accomplishment, possession or talent which causes a desire for recognition, honor, congratulations or acknowledgement.

5. Blasphemers

Anyone that speaks, acts, writes or otherwise communicates contempt or lack of reverence for God or sacred things. Can also mean one who clams the ability of qualities of God (2 Thessalonians 2:3-4). Irreverence, disrespect, defiance or dishonor displayed toward God (Father, Son and/or Holy Spirit!) or sacred things.
