

## **2 Timothy 3:2**

### **DEFINITIONS**

#### **1. Lovers of Their Own Selves**

Those that are consumed with their own interests; put themselves and their own interests above all else; self-promoting; self-devoted; self-enamored.

#### **2. Covetous**

Wanting, craving or desiring a thing – specifically something belonging to another person (See [Exodus 20:17](#)). May include possessions, positions, abilities (talents, skills, giftings, etc.) or power (influence).

(See [Ephesians 5:5](#) and [Colossians 3:5](#))

#### **3. Boastful**

Showing (displaying; communicating) excessive pride in one's own achievements, accomplishments, possessions, talents or abilities. Bragging; vaunting oneself up ([1 Corinthians 13:4](#)); ostentatious (displaying one's wealth, knowledge, skill, ability or appearance (looks) in a way meant to attract attention, admiration and envy).

#### **4. Proud**

A deep feeling of satisfaction or importance – as a result of one's own achievement, accomplishment, possession or talent which causes a desire for recognition, honor, congratulations or acknowledgement.

#### **5. Blasphemers**

Anyone that speaks, acts, writes or otherwise communicates contempt or lack of reverence for God or sacred things. Can also mean one who claims the ability of qualities of God ([2 Thessalonians 2:3-4](#)). Irreverence, disrespect, defiance or dishonor displayed toward God (Father, Son and/or Holy Spirit!) or sacred things.
